In this week's box, from your farmer you can expect:

- Tomatoes
- Bell pepper
- The LAST melon of the year
- Cucumbers
- Dill
- Russet Burbank potatoes
- Green onions
- Farmers choice
- Carrots
- Leaf lettuce

What to Expect. Starting the first week of October you will start getting pumpkins and winter squash. I am not sure of the exact schedule, but we hope to provide pumpkins for about 3 weeks in October. You will get winter squash when the small pumpkins are in your boxes, no squashes when you get the big pumpkin(s) and when the pumpkins are gone, then you get the larger squash. The gourds should come in the November boxes-or so we have planned. This is the last of the melons. We will have tomatoes for a while longer, carrots for quite a while. We have some beets and other assorted fall crops coming along.

Cardoon. Next week you will be getting cardoon. This could be one of the more challenging vegetables you will get all year. We will send some recipes in advance, but I would encourage you to do a little research on this thing.

Surplus produce. We have surplus potatoes, eggplant, carrots, green onions and eggplant.

Winter CSA. There are about 30 memberships remaining. Some time around the beginning of October we will open the Winter CSA to people not in the Summer CSA. Let us know if you think are interested.

Fall Harvest Party. The Fall Harvest Party is this Saturday. We do not have a lot of RSVPs yet-we only have about 50 people signed up. If you are interested in attending please let us know. We have attached a note about requesting volunteers to help out. We need some folks to grill, to help set up, to help with serving and clean up.
