Schreiber & Sons Community Supported Agriculture began giving Tri-Cities families a chance to share in local farming in 2006. For a fee, CSA members receive a box of seasonal produce every week during the 28 week harvest season, which stretches from May through November. We offer small, medium and large shares. With your produce, you will receive nutritional information, recipes and serving suggestions for most products and your family will become part of a local community that appreciates fresh produce and values agriculture.

Schreiber & Sons Farm

Schreiber & Sons Farm is an extension of Agriculture Development Group, Inc., a private independent agricultural research company in Eltopia (16 miles north of Pasco). Alan Schreiber left Washington State University in 1998 to start up his own research company. The production end of the business was established in 2004 to address an unmet demand in the Pacific Northwest for locally grown, specialty produce.

CSA Registration and Payment

- Registration is on a first-come-first-serve basis.
- Price is based on an estimated 28 week season: May 3-November 10. Mother Nature may lengthen or shorten this period.
- A \$50 deposit for a small share and \$100 deposit for medium and large share will hold your position.
- Registration can be completed by mail or on our Website. Payments can be made by check, Paypal or electronic check (via our Website).
- You can pay all at once or you can pay 50% by May 2 and the remaining 50% by July 1. No refunds will be given after July 1, 2011.
- See the website for more details.
- If you refer a friend to us, you will get a \$20 coupon for produce and they will get a discount based on the size of their share. Feel free to sign up as many folks as you can.

Enjoy you own personal farmer

- *You will receive deliveries of local produce weekly.*
- *You will pay for flavor, freshness and quality—rather than transportation. (The average item of produce in a grocery store travels over 1,000 miles.)*
- *You will embark upon a culinary adventure and try things you didn't realize existed. Of the thousands of varieties of produce, the average household may consume 25, at most, during the year. We will provide you with top quality, conventional favorites, while introducing you to fruits, vegetables and nutritional goldmines that may never have entered your kitchen before.*
- *We want you to know your farmer and see your produce grow. At least two parties are organized each year for members to visit the farm, meet other members, and share recipes. Additional farm visits can be arranged with previous notice.*

Joining a CSA is healthy, interesting and easy.

Become a LOCAVORE— someone who tries to eat as much locally grown food as possible.

Delivery and Produce

- Produce is delivered to drop off sites throughout the Tri-Cities. Shares can be picked up during a specific window of time. For exact delivery times and locations go to Schreiberand sons.com.
- 95% of all produce in CSA deliveries is grown on our farm north of Pasco. The rest is sourced from other local farmers.
- In the past, we have offered both organic and conventional shares. We found this to be overly time consuming and inefficient. Thus, in 2011, we will not be offering conventional or organic; just a share. All shares will be about 85% organic produce. If a member wishes to receive only organic produce, we will accommodate that wish, but diversity of box content will be reduced. We reserve the right to make substitutions.
- There will be four pick up locations on Tuesday and another four on Thursday and one on Wednesday at the Pasco Farmers Market.
- **The Choice Option.** For an additional \$80 per season, you can design your own box content. Each week you will be given a list of items from which to choose. Make your selections and receive a custom box of produce-this is a great deal!

- **The Giant Pumpkin.** All CSA members are eligible to pick up a giant pumpkin.
